

“Monozukuri” Craftsmanship Developing Teamwork

Japan’s population decline is raising fears of a future labor shortage in the construction business. How to hand on traditional monozukuri craftsmanship skills is also becoming a major issue. The Pahang-Selangor Raw Water Transfer Project, carried put over six years from 2009, involved the construction of a 44.6-kilometer-long tunnel, the longest in S. E. Asia. Challenging worksite issues included unexpected water springs, a bedrock with a temperature of over 55° Celsius, and breakdowns suffered by two of the three excavation machines. But despite these difficult conditions, the multinational construction team successfully completed the project. Overseeing the work there was a top tunneling expert. What is the spirit of monozukuri craftsmanship, and how can it be preserved? The program considers the answers.
